Guidelines for Wedding Flowers 2024

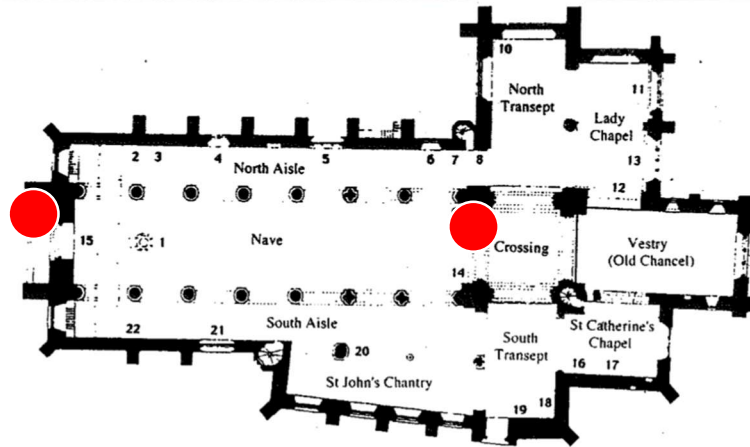


Congratulations on your forthcoming wedding!

We are able to offer an 'in-house' facility for wedding flowers at St Peter's. In order that these arrangements work smoothly for your wedding, we have set out some guidelines to assist in your planning.

Flower locations

As a general rule, there will normally be one flower pedestal in church on the chancel step near the pulpit and one in the porch; these you have for the £130 standing charge. However, they will not be in place during Lent and Advent (the weeks preceding Easter and Christmas). If you require flowers at these times this can be arranged. If your wedding takes place when the church is decorated for a festival (ie. Christmas or Easter) the floral arrangements that are in the church for that festival will be used.



What to do next

Please take the following into consideration:

- If you would like any particular flowers or a colour to suit your theme our recommendations for arrangements are two pedestals in the chancel area and one in the porch. Our charges are £90 for each pedestal and £70 for the porch pedestal which should be paid at least six weeks before your wedding. Bank details will be given on your invoice from the parish office for an online bank transfer or you may pay by cheque.
- It is expected that the arrangements will remain in the church after your wedding.
- If there is more than one wedding in the same weekend and all couples require special flower arrangements, then a compromise may need to be made on the colour or type of flowers and the cost would then be shared.
