The Second David Pearce Memorial Lecture



Captain John Tye was one of only 134 pilots to ever fly Concorde for British Airways in the whole 27 years the supersonic airliner was in service. Concorde first flew in March 1969. John will take us through the extensive training course, the toughest in aviation, and on a virtual flight from Heathrow to New York. He will explain some of the unique technical features of Concorde

as well as many amusing anecdotes along the way, leaving us believing that Concorde was the greatest icon of the 20th century.
